
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Soap/Lotion Dispensers

Part #'s: 1205, 1206





INSTALLATION

- 1. Drill 1-3/16" wide hole (minimum) in sink or counter. Place threaded part of pump body through the hole. Note: Maximum counter thickness is 1". Use extension kit SD-EXT to fit counters up to 2-1/2".
- 2. From underneath counter, thread 1200-6 nut onto pump body
- 3. Screw plastic bottle into female thread of pump body.
- 4. To add liquid soap or lotion, lift pump cap 1205-3/4 or 1206-3/4 (pump remains attached) and pour into dispenser body. Replace pump cap and pump several times. Liquid should flow from spout.

REFILLING SOAP/LOTION

- 1. Lift off cap, but do not separate pump from cap.
- 2. Refill by pouring liquid into top of pump body. Do not over-fill (liquid should remain in plastic bottle).

PUMP MAINTENANCE

Liquid soaps vary in consistency and may harden over time. Follow the procedures below if the pump fails to operate.

- 1. Remove cap and pump assembly and place tube into a glass of warm water. Pump several times until water pumps freely.
- 2. If the mechanism still fails to operate properly, insert a pipe cleaner into the tube to clear any obstructing soap from the plastic and metal tubing. Follow up by soaking in warm water.
