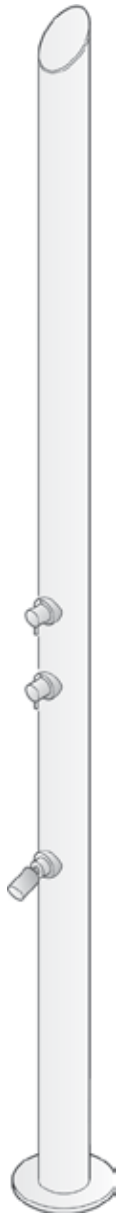

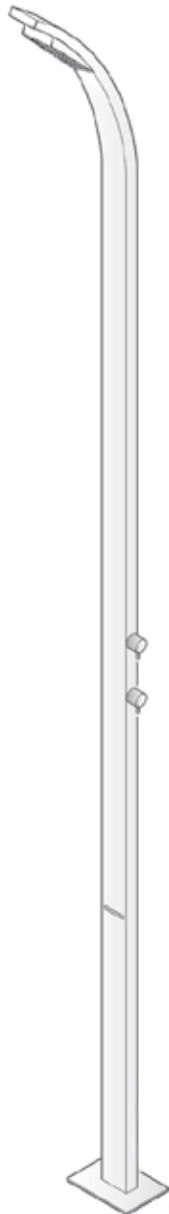
Outdoor Shower Columns

Product Number: Aqua Adagio (1800 & 1805) & Arc Column (1900 & 1905)

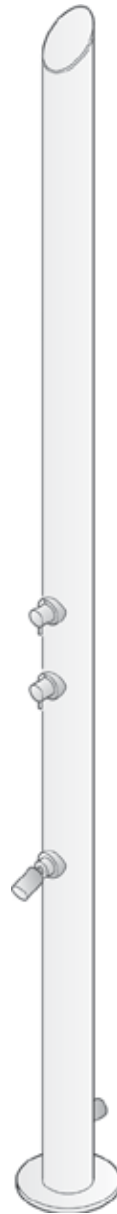
Please read instructions carefully before beginning the installation.



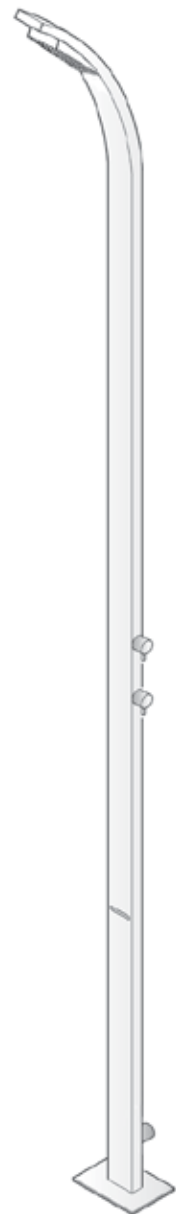

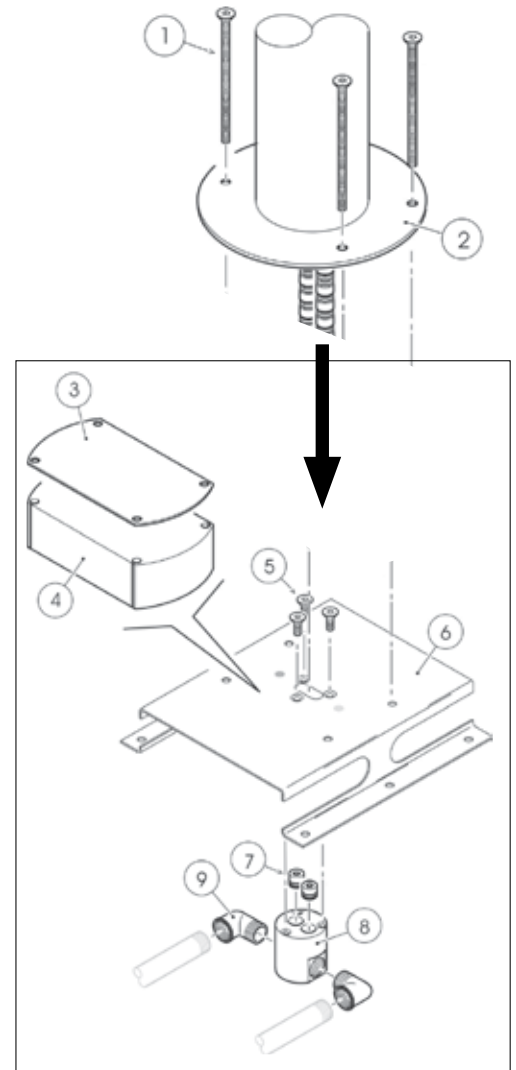
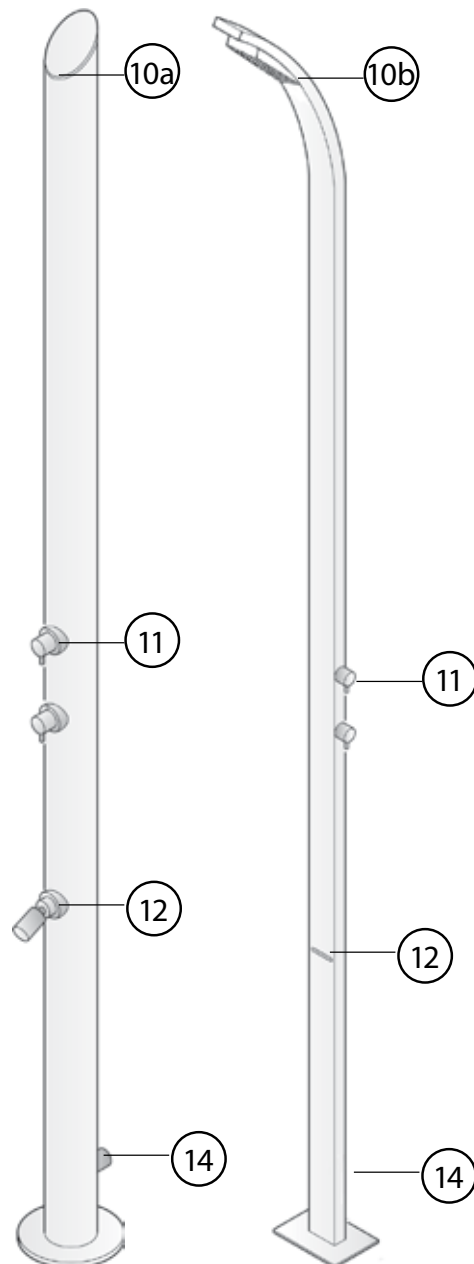
COMPONENTS

- 1) Screws
- 2) Swimming pool shower column
- 3) Cover
- 4) Polystyrene plug
- 5) Screw for fixing connector
- 6) Ground bracket
- 7) Protective plugs
- 8) Fixing connector
- 9) Curved fittings
- 10a) Waterfall jet diffuser
- 10b) Easy-Clean self-cleaning rainfall jet diffuser
- 11) 2 control valves with progressive cartridges
- 12) Foot wash nozzle
- 13) Screws for polystyrene plug (3+4)

Renovation column only:

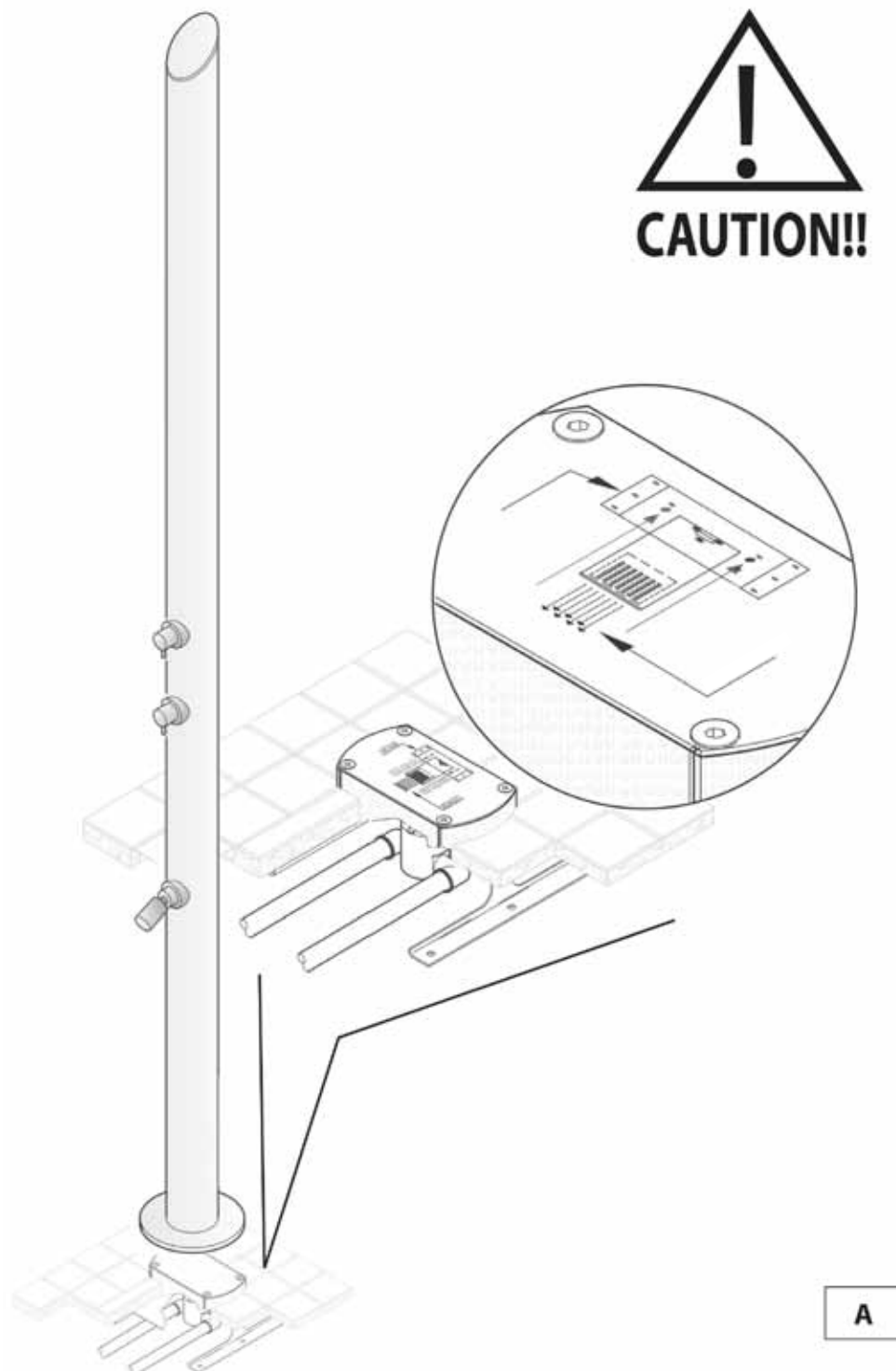
- 14) 3/4" M attachment for garden hose
- 15) Screws and plugs

NB: Important! Make sure that you put aside those components needed to maintain the column during the winter months (3, 4, 7, 13) during assembly and keep them somewhere safe.



WARNING

In order to install the outdoor shower column correctly (grounded in the earth), you must first check that your designers/installers know which direction you want the water spray to come from (Fig. A). This is because the direction in which the shower column is facing at installation is determined by the direction of the fixing connector, as indicated on the label stuck to the cover (3). It is therefore important to accurately define the position and direction of the fixing connector before proceeding to the subsequent stages.

Fig.B: Connect the curved pipes (9) to the supply system.

Fig.C: Make sure that the support is perfectly level.

Fig.D: Complete the paving, making sure that you keep the minimum distances shown in the image.

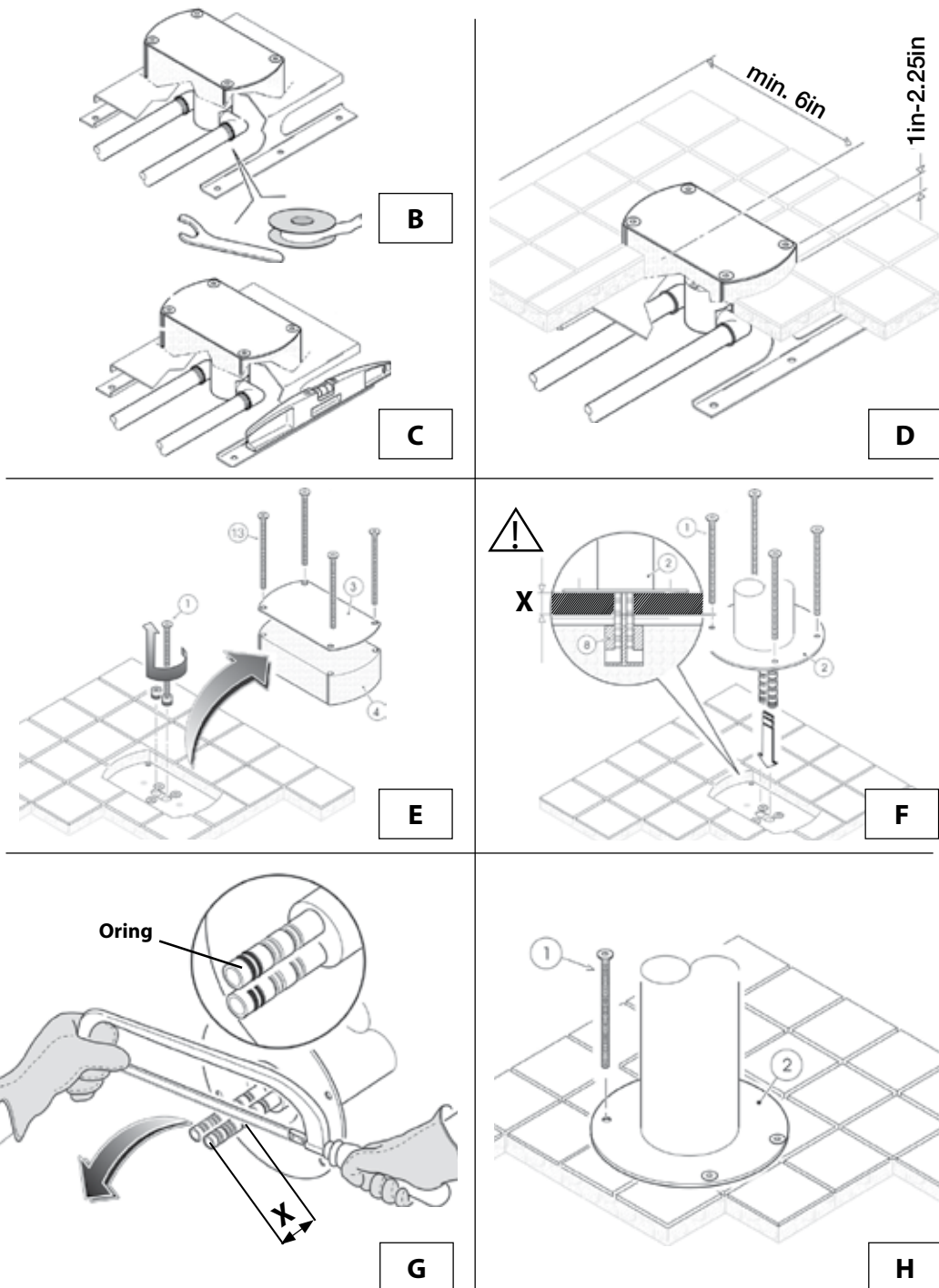
Fig.E: Remove the polystyrene (4) and cover (3), unscrewing the four screws (13). Then remove the two plugs of the base using one of the screws.

Flush out the system to make sure that any impurity in the pipes is removed.

Fig.F: Insert the column (2) into the base using (8), checking to see if there is any gap between the column base and the pavement (see X).

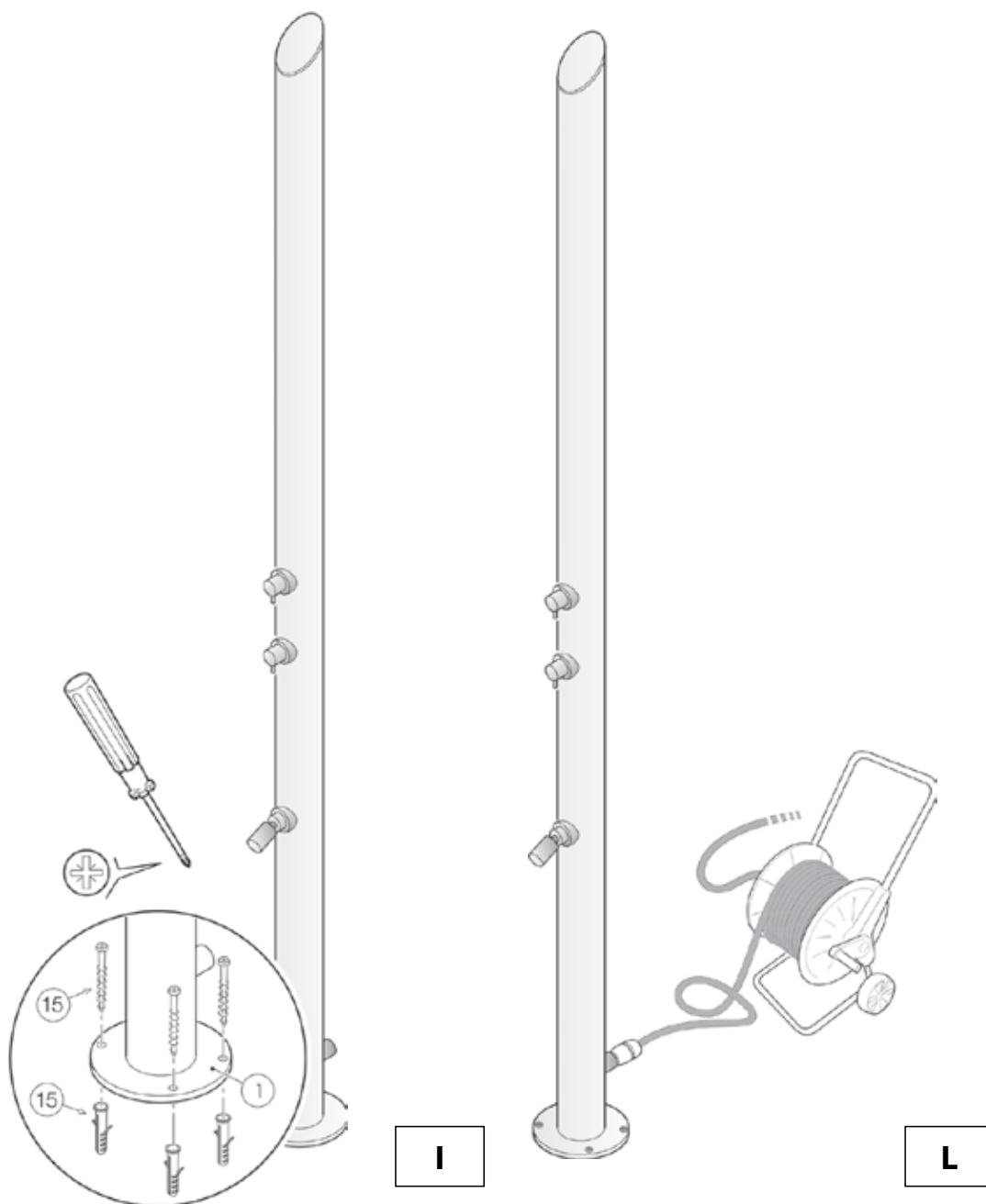
Fig.G: If there is a gap, shorten the attachments by cutting them by as least as much as shown in X and reposition the O-Rings in the two most prominent places.

Fig.H: Insert the column (2), check that it is perfectly rooted in the ground and fix it using the four screws (1) together with the fixing connector.

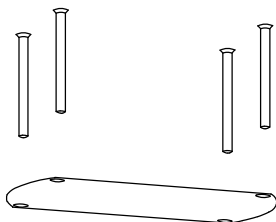
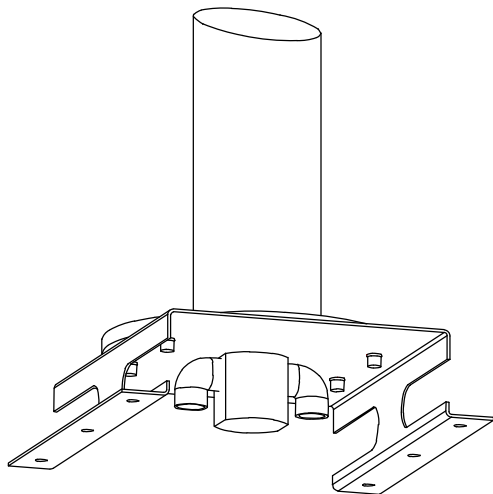
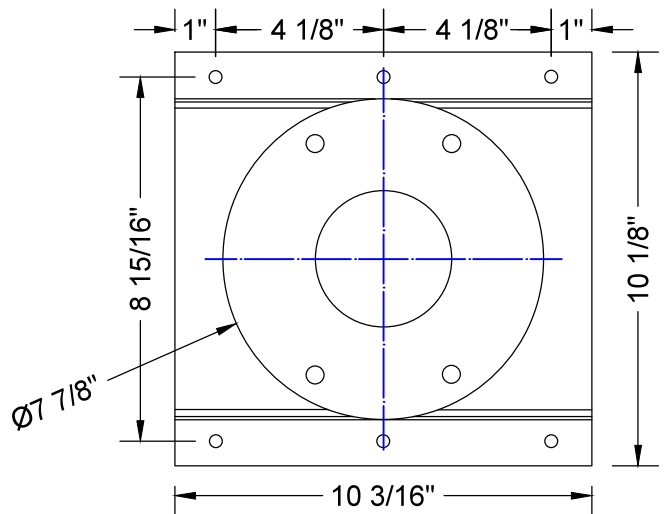
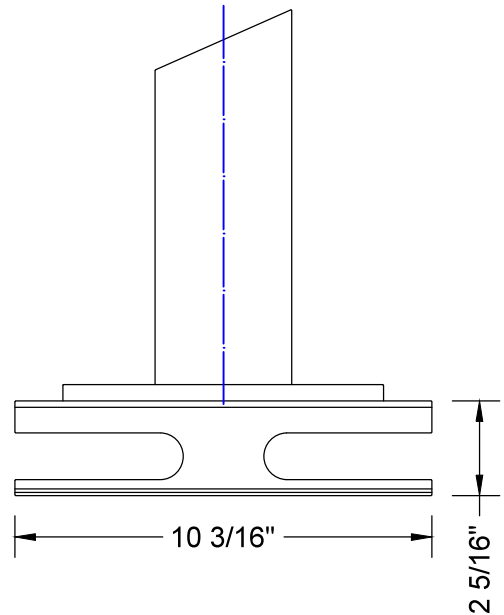
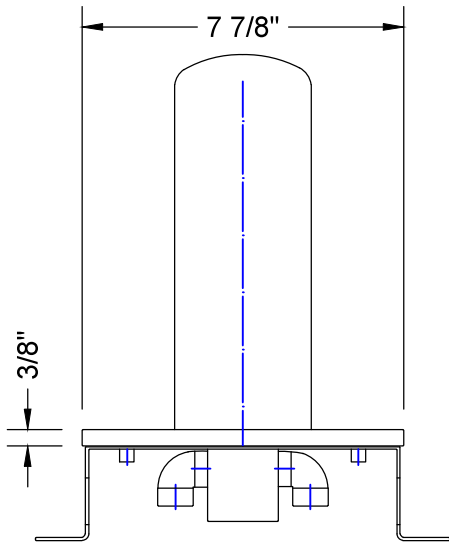


INSTALLATION

Fig.I: Fix the column using the 4 screws and plugs (15) included in the pack.
Fig.L: Link the 3/4" M attachment to the garden hose.
